- Receive support from health and/or social care services
- Are financially vulnerable
- Have emerging or diagnosed mental health needs
- Are homeless or at risk of homelessness
- Are young carers
- Are 'looked after' or have a child protection plan
- Have Education, Health and Care plans (EHCPs)
- Are affected by domestic or sexual violence or abuse
- Have parents with mental health problems, alcohol or drug addictions
